Progress

In the past school year, we have organized systems for supporting students through collaboration among staff, families and students on many different levels. We have a 50% decrease in calls being made for behavior support at the classroom level due to the number of systems and strategies we put into place for trusting relationships to develop among our staff and students. We began developing a process that will continue to develop so that our students have opportunities for leadership on many levels. We have organized a number of opportunities through our Community School efforts for our families, children and community to have access to resources; food pantry, after school programming, ESL & GED classes, and more!

Area for Growth

Leopold will continue to work on improving student outcomes in reading proficiency across grades K-5 through collaborative planning and using culturally/linguistically responsive practices that support children becoming both independent and interdependent learners. We strive to more fully develop all children and adults seeing their diverse identities, strengths and assets represented and utilized in our school. We want to make sure to share all the great things happening at Leopold throughout the school year so that the community is drawn to all that is good in our Community School.

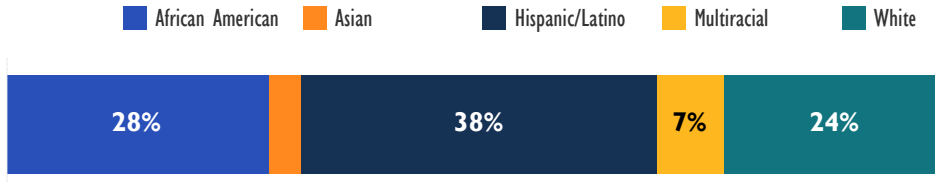

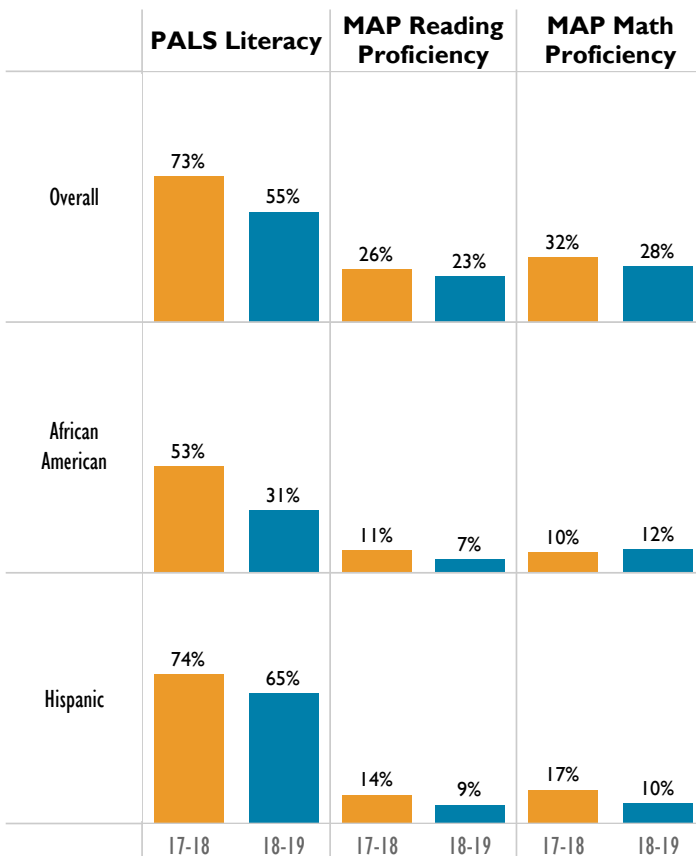
