Strengths

One of Leopold's biggest strengths is our diverse community which is engaged in a partnership with us to promote improved student outcomes. Our multilingual and multicultural staff are committed to meeting student and family needs. Our families create a deep cultural and linguistic tapestry that enriches all that we do. Our community partners, who helped us to achieve our Community School status, are a never-ending source of generosity and goodwill.

Progress

This past year we continued to strengthen our Literacy Instruction utilizing a five-day progression. Our efforts around building strong teams and using small learning communities with our large staff meant that we saw a 15% increase in the Relationships domain of the Staff Climate Survey. As well, with the development of our Community School model and increased efforts with two-way communications with families, we had a 15% increase in the Family Engagement domain of the Family Climate Survey.

Area for Growth

At Leopold, we know that sustaining a focus on quality teaching and learning is key to the long-term success of our families. Our improvement work for this school year will continue the learning we began previously. One new element we are very excited to add is a focus on mathematics. We will be implementing a new math curriculum and will be threading the Mathematical Practice Standard of perseverance in problem-solving throughout the academic day. Along with our work around academic planning & instruction, we will be intensifying our work around social emotional learning skills.

Our school supports MMSD's vision that all students acquire the skills and abilities needed to be successful, including a mastery of content areas, growth mindset, self-knowledge, creativity, wellness, interpersonal skills, confidence, cultural competence, and community connection. 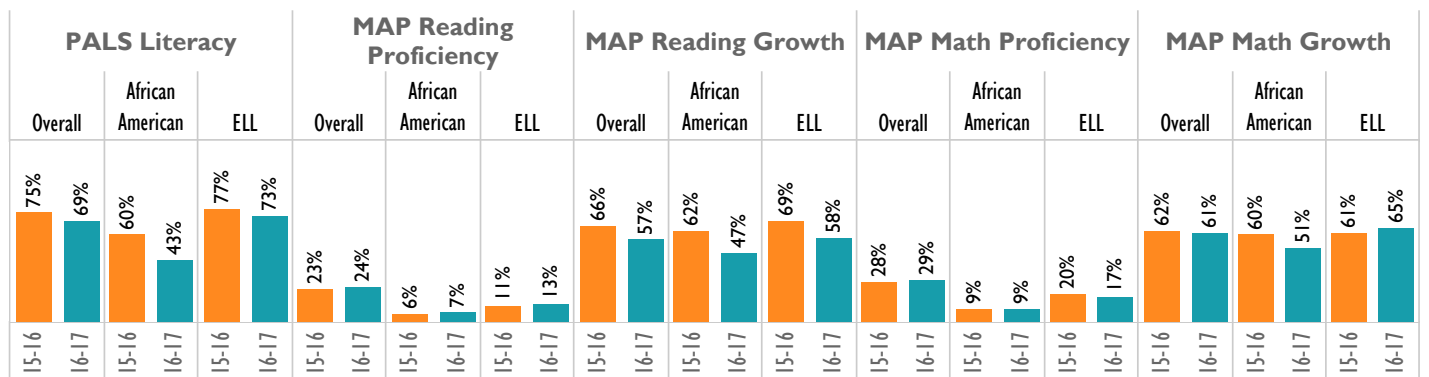

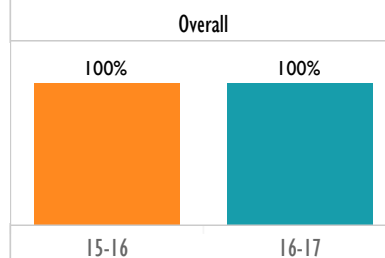
Strategic Framework Goal #1 Milestones: On-Track to Graduate
